MADRID LABOR DAYS CO-ED SAND VOLLEYBALL TOURNAMENT GAME RULES

TEAMS

Six Player leagues: Teams shall be composed of SIX, with at least three women and two men on the sand at all times.

TIMING AND SCORING REGULATIONS

Rally scoring will be used

A game is over when one team scores 21 points. The winning team must have at least a two point advantage. The match is over if;

- (a) one team wins two out of three games,
- (b) the third game, if needed, is played to 15. In a third game situation, the win by 2 rule is not in effect.

SERVING REGULATIONS

1. A coin toss will be done between the two opposing captains. The winner has the choice of: serving the first game or choosing which court to start on. At the beginning of the second game the roles are reversed.
2. The coin toss will be done at the beginning of the third game with the winner getting the same options as above. Teams will not switch courts in the middle of the third game.
3. Serving out of turn:
If a player serves out of turn, side-out shall be called as soon as the mistake is discovered. Any points made by the illegal server shall be cancelled. The serving order should then be corrected immediately.
4. Players must stay in their respective serving order for the entire game. At the beginning of a new game the players may be rearranged.

PLAYING THE GAME

1. The ball must be given immediate contact. A player may not hit the ball twice in succession. When playing the ball, **the player may use any part of their body, including feet.**
2. The ball may be contacted a maximum of three times by a team before it is sent over the net.

3. If two or more players of the same team contact the ball simultaneously, it is considered one play. The players involved may participate in the next play. This next play should be counted as an additional contact.

4. Ball crossing the net:

a. If the ball touches the net on the return, it must touch the net between the markers and go over into the opponent's court.

b. A ball, to include a served, striking the net and going over is still in play.

c. The ball may be played when any part of it has crossed the top of the net. It is not essential for the entire ball to be on a player's side of the net before played.

d. The only legal double hit allowed is if when executing a block, the ball comes through the hands and hits another part of the player's body.

5. Illegal Net Play

a. Holding or pushing the ball against the net.

b. Touching the net with any part of the body while the ball is in play. If the ball is driven into the net with such it causes the net to contact a player on the opposing team, no foul shall be called and the ball shall continue to be in play.

c. Reaching over the net:

a. If a player reaches over the net on the follow through a foul shall not be called.

d. If a player in an attempt to block reaches over the net on a follow-through, whether or not they touch the ball, a foul shall not be called. (Provided some part of the ball has crossed the net on the blocker's side before the follow-through occurs.)

e. If during an attempt to block a ball, the ball is hit against the net with such force that it causes the net to move under the fingers or hand of the blocker, no fouls shall be called.

6. Reaching under the net:

A player may not reach under the net and touch the ball or a player on the opposing team when the ball is in play on the opponent's side of the court.

7. Legal net play:

a. A ball other than a service may be recovered from the net provided the player avoids touching the net.

b. If two or more players from opposing teams contact the ball simultaneously above the net, any of the players involved are eligible to participate in the next play which shall be considered the first of three contacts allowed to the team. When a ball is contacted simultaneously by both teams and it becomes motionless, a replay is ruled.

c. If one or more players is attempting to block and is contacted by the ball, this player is eligible to participate in
